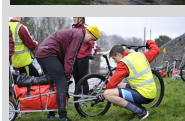

Choosing your expedition – do I need lots of experience or special gear?

The general answer is no, as SEEE has invested in canoeing and biking kit so you can try these new activities without needing to purchase any major kit.

e.g. Biking

Bike packing is quite a new type of cycling – so we find many Explorers think it will need very high levels of skill or experience and special bikes.

- There is no "technical" mountain bike type of riding, and a basic level of cycling skill like riding a typical bike on country roads will be ok. Both wheels of the bike stay on the ground at all times.
- Routes are on forest roads, gravel tracks and away from public roads as much as possible.
- The only bike that isn't suitable is a road racing bike – due to the very narrow tyres with no tread for non-tarmac roads
- We provide panniers, saddle bags, frame bags etc. to fit most bike frames
- No special clothing needed except a helmet

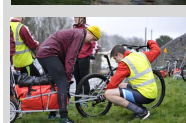

Expedition Requirements

Level	Duration	Practice Needed	Minimum hours of planned activity each day
Bronze	2 days and 1 night	No	At least 6 hours during the daytime (at least 3 of which must be spent journeying)
Silver	3 days and 2 nights	Yes	At least 7 hours during the daytime (at least 3½ of which must be spent journeying)
Gold	4 days and 3 nights	Yes	At least 8 hours during the daytime (at least 4 of which must be spent journeying)

- If you already have completed a practice expedition, you will need to attend some refresher training and can take part in the qualifying expedition without completing a practice this year.
- Most Explorers aim to complete Bronze in S3, Silver in S4 and Gold in S5 or S6. If you are a completing an expedition in a later year group than that, please do email us and we can discuss if there are any options to catch-up.
- For Bronze expeditions, no presentation is required.

- ✓ There is no practice expedition required at Bronze Level, but training is required.
- ✓ Many Units and Districts run Bronze expeditions locally.
- ✓ We will discuss with your District/Unit whether this will be possible and let you know.
- ✓ If that isn't possible, we will arrange extra expeditions. Most of the details we cover tonight refer to expeditions run by SEEE, but please pay attention, as you may be on one of them.

Silver – Preparing for your expedition

- ✓ Basic Expedition Skills Training
 - only you are starting at Silver as a Direct Entrant
- ✓ Online & Outdoor training sessions to develop your skills further
- ✓ First Aid Training
- ✓ A practice expedition
 - ✓ 2 days and 2 nights camping out
 - ✓ In similar terrain to your Qualifying expedition
 - ✓ In the same group as your Qualifying expedition, or as close as practical.
- ✓ Planning and training – details will follow
 - ✓ Refresh expedition skills for more demanding expedition level
 - ✓ Your route, menu, and getting all your gear ready
 - ✓ Choose and plan your project
- ✓ The Qualifying Expedition
 - ✓ 3 days / 2 nights
 - ✓ Your presentation, about 2 weeks after the expedition

Gold – Preparing for your expedition

- ✓ Basic Expedition Skills Training
 - only if this is you are starting at Gold as a Direct Entrant
- ✓ Online & Outdoor training sessions to develop your skills further
- ✓ First Aid Training (more later)
 - ✓ **At least two in each group to hold 2-Day First Aid qualification**
 - ✓ **Allows expeditions to be held in remote terrain.**
- ✓ A practice expedition
 - ✓ 2 days and 2 nights camping out
 - ✓ In similar terrain to your Qualifying expedition
 - ✓ In the same group as your Qualifying expedition, or as close as practical.
- ✓ Planning and training – details will follow
 - ✓ Refresh expedition skills for more demanding expedition level
 - ✓ Your route, menu, and getting all your gear ready
 - ✓ Choose and plan your project
- ✓ The Qualifying Expedition
 - ✓ **4 days / 3 nights in progressively more challenging terrain to Silver**
 - ✓ **You need to be in expedition area night before (so 4 nights away)**
 - ✓ Your presentation, about 2 weeks after the expedition

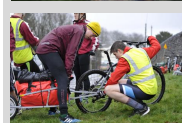
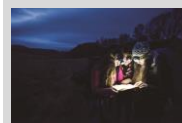


Expedition Plans

- ✓ Likely to run more than one set of dates for levels due to high numbers.
- ✓ Schools are typically happy to agree to one or two days of absence from school to complete one of the longer DofE expeditions – let them know as soon as you have your expedition dates confirmed..

Level of Award	Dates
Bronze / Silver Practice/ Gold Practice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • April – June (aware of SQA Nat 5, Higher and Adv. Higher windows)
Silver Assessed/ Gold Assessed	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Mid/late August (preference given to participants not returning to School) • September (incl. 13th- 15th Sept Autumn holiday weekend) • Early October

- All of our activities are run in line with Scouting rules for safety relevant for the type of expedition and location/route
- We will always try to have others from your Unit included in your Group, providing they have signed up as well, so you should know others in your expedition.

How much does it cost?

Level	Breakdown
Guideline total SEEE expedition costs	Training, practice and assessed expeditions as required
Bronze £15-35 (District/Unit/SEEE)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Training – £0-10 (2 training days) Qualifying Expedition – £15-25 (2 days, Pentlands)
Silver £70-130	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Training – £10-20 (2 training days) Practice Expedition (2 days/2 nights) – £50-70 Qualifying Expedition (3 days/2 nights) – £65-85
Gold £90-180	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Training – £10-20 (2 training days) Advanced First Aid – £30 (optional – 2 in each group need to hold) Practice Expedition (2 days/2 nights) – £30-60 Qualifying Expedition (4 days/4 nights) – £50-100

Parents are asked to arrange transport to/from the expedition area for their participants, and we encourage car sharing.
